he words of John 6:37 reveal the purpose of the Father in giving his elect to Jesus Christ. The Father's purpose was that they might come to him and be saved. This, says the Son, shall indeed be done. Sin, Satan, the flesh, or the world shall never hinder their coming to Christ. The Lord Jesus positively determined to put forth such a sufficiency of grace, that it will effectually perform this promise, and use all the means necessary to accomplish this purpose. The Father's end will not be frustrated (John 6:39). By coming, we understand it to be the coming of the mind to Him, and the moving of the heart towards Him. It is a coming with the absolute desire to be justified and saved. There needs to be the sense of a lost condition to move him to come. This made the three thousand come; it made the jailer come; and indeed makes all others come effectually. Death is before them and they see it and feel it, and it feeds upon them, and will eat them guite up if they do not come to Jesus Christ. They come of necessity, being forced into it by the sense they have of their being utterly and everlastingly undone, if they do not find safety in Him.
