THE OMNIPRESENT GOD


Can a man hide himself in secret places so that I cannot see him? declares the LORD. Do I not fill heaven and earth? —Jeremiah 23: 24

God knows all that is done in the most secret caverns of the heart. No place is deprived of His presence. Though reason and Scripture declare it, we cannot conceive it.
